VACANCY FOR TRAINEE CIVIL ENGINEERS

The Roads Authority (RA) is a Statutory Corporation created by Act No. 3 of 2006 to ensure that public roads are constructed, maintained or rehabilitated at all times; and to advise the Minister, and where appropriate, the Minister responsible for Local Government on the preparation and efficient and effective implementation of the Annual National Roads Programme.

The Roads Authority (RA) is looking for young and enthusiastic fresh graduates in Civil Engineering of Malawi origin to undergo a hands on but intensive training in the management of various technical activities of civil works projects by way of participating in the implementation of Nsipe-Liwonde road rehabilitation project, Liwonde-Matawale road rehabilitation project and the M1 road rehabilitation project with a stretch from Kamuzu International Airport junction to Mzimba turn off and then from Kacheche to Chiweta.

This is a paid training which will last twelve (12) months and the trained engineers will be released to the market to apply the knowledge and skills attained.

Prospective trainees will be graduates who are not employed but have a Degree in Civil Engineering obtained from a recognized University in the last twenty-four (24) months, good computer literacy, and ability to work in a team environment and to follow instructions.
